Terms and Conditions

Please read the following event policies carefully. Check mark each condition to acknowledge that you have read and accepted each Policy.

- 1. Booth fee for a 10ft x 10ft space at the Arnprior Robert Simpson Park event will be <u>\$75.00</u> including advertising.
- Entrance Fee for the Tart Competition is \$10 per entry plus 6 Tarts to be judged for each entry.
 a. Note that <u>one entry</u> in each of the Traditional and Wild categories per person is allowed.
- 3. A deposit of \$40.00 is to be included with application, & the balance paid by <u>e-transfer</u> (please use Password Hint of Town: [Arnprior]) or post dated cheque dated no later than July 21, 2024, payable to the Arnprior Rotary Club.
- 4. Pictures and a list of what items you will be selling must be included with your application (unless you are repeating last years items). All items are to be baked or crafted by the participants themselves.

Important Dates

- 1. Last date to preregister will be July 21, 2024. After that date the next person on the waiting list will be given first choice.
- 2. July 31, 2024 Notification of Accepted Vendors

DAY of the EVENT

- 1. Booths must be set up between <u>7:30 and 9:30 am</u> and occupied and vehicles removed from site by 9:30 am Saturday, August 24, 2024.
- 2. Booths must have an attendant on duty at all times during the show.

- 3. No display racks, etc. are to be more than 6' high & you are required to provide your own tables.
- 4. <u>NO ONE</u> will dismantle their booth before closing on Saturday August 24, 2024 without advance approval from the Festival Organizers.
- 5. Failure to follow the rules of this show will disqualify you for other Rotary Events.
- 6. First choice for the 2025 Fair will go to those who attended this show.
- 7. No advertised SALES or discounting allowed.

INSURANCE

1. Liability insurance is generally covered by the Rotary Club for this event but we encourage individuals and business to provide their own.

FEES

- 1. Once payment is made I/we understand that I am holding a spot so reservations for this event are nonrefundable.
- 2. The Baker or Vendor agrees that The Arnprior Rotary Club assumes no responsibility or liability for any loss suffered, as a result of the Baker/Vendor participating in this event.
- 3. Every effort will be made to operate the event however; if the event is cancelled due to reasons beyond the Rotary Club of Arnprior's Control such as acts of God, Government Decree, fire, weather, pandemic, natural disaster, ordinances by legal authority, no refunds will be issued.
