

## Rotary Respite Care Program Employment Eligibility Requirements for Respite Care Coordinator and Care Givers

Because a significant portion of the funding for the Rotary Club of Bowmanville's Summer Respite Care Program is provided by the Canada Summer Jobs Program and because of the nature of the Program itself, a number of requirements exist for applicants to be eligible for employment in the Program. To be eligible for employment the applicant **must**:

- be between 17 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred. Note that international students and youth awaiting a refugee status ruling, as well as those who hold a temporary visitor visa, youth visa, or work visa are **NOT** eligible;
- have a valid Social Insurance Number and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with Canadian and Ontario legislation and regulations;
- have a valid G2 or G class Driver's Licence and full daily access to a car;
- preferably have an educational background in a field of study related to child care such as nursing, teaching, early childhood education, social work, etc.;
- have a clear and current Criminal Reference Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening;
- have current Level C CPR Certification from a recognized provider;
- have current First Aid Certification from a recognized provider;
- be prepared to work the hours and perform the duties outlined in the Respite Care Coordinator or Respite Care Giver Job Description as applicable.
