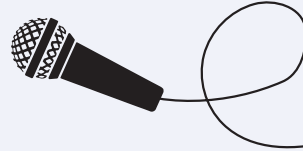

DR. PETER JÜNI

is an internationally-renowned epidemiologist and as the Scientific Director of the Ontario COVID-19 Science Advisory Table which has been informing the government's response to COVID-19, has been often quoted by the news media. After fulfilling her promise to see the National Inquiry into Missing & Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls initiated in October 2016, Dawn left her role as National Leader to become Director at the First Peoples House of Learning at Trent University. As president of the Ontario Native Women's Charitable Foundation, she raises funds to support Indigenous women's education.

TODD SIMKOVER

Todd Simkover has a M.A. in Critical Disability Studies from York University. He is an autism researcher and consultant focusing on post-secondary education and the labour market through a neurodiversity lens, and an emerging motivational speaker, author, and blogger. He is driven by his own lived experiences on the autism spectrum.

FARIDA NEKZAD

A defender of women's rights and freedom of expression, Farida Nekzad is Director of the Center for the Protection of Afghan Women Journalists. She's a co-founder of Pajhwok Afghan News, and since 2003, has trained some 2,000 journalists and students. Following the Taliban takeover, she fled Afghanistan with her daughter and is now a Journalist-in-Residence at Carleton University in Ottawa.
