MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Rotary members are actively engaged in our community, building new projects, promoting community partnerships, and supporting Rotary initiatives globally. In Etobicoke, our efforts have resulted in major donations, program development, and ongoing volunteer service.

Over the years, Rotary Etobicoke has raised over \$4M, benefiting over 110 organizations, including After Breast Cancer, Anduhyaun Women's Shelter, Arts Etobicoke, Dorothy Ley Hospice, Elisa House, Ernestine's Women's Shelter, Etobicoke General Hospital, Franklin Horner, Haven on Queensway, Kids Against Hunger, Rexdale Community Centre, Salvation Army, St. Joseph's Health Centre, Trillium Health Partners, Women's Habitat, and Youth Without Shelter.

Main projects:

- Toronto Ribfest - This event is entirely organized by Rotarians and staffed by 100% volunteers. It is Toronto's largest ribfest and the club's primary fundraising event, serving as the cornerstone for many of our projects to lift up our community. Toronto Ribfest happens on Canada Day long weekend.
- Hands-On - Project outreach is a big community supporter across Etobicoke and connects the Club with agencies, shelters, churches, community centers, and food banks.
