Speaker – Lorraine Sunstrum-Mann

Lorraine Sunstrum-Mann shared with the Club information regarding the Ontario Children's Treatment Centres, the history of Grandview and an update on their \$20 million fundraising campaign. Lorraine shared the Centre's increase in demand for services for children in the community and noted the Centre will be establishing a satellite campus in Oshawa in a local school (to replace the facility that is being sold). She noted a \$5 million gap in budget and 300-400 children on the waiting list for services. She also noted that 32% of clients come from Oshawa (20% from Whitby; 27% from Ajax Pickering; 16% east of Oshawa; and 5% from northern Durham Region).
