### **Speaker – BRIAN KELLY, Manager of Sustainability, Region of Durham**

Brian talked about the climate change that is happening here in Durham Region. He gave statistical analysis of how the climate temperature has changed over the past 10 years by an average of 2 degrees Celsius and how it will continue to increase in the
