





Port Hope Rotary Club Board Structure 2023 - 2024

INCREASE COMMUNITY VISIBILITY & ENGAGEMENT – SERVICE PROJECTS

• To achieve positive change in Port Hope we will advocate projects that are valued by the residents and encourage them to engage with our Club. Action through our community.

- Implement a big project that has wide community appeal and need (e.g. walk-in clinic)
- Implement smaller projects that appeal to a broad base
- Blend of project timeframes. Some longer-term and quick win projects
- Set a **realistic number** of service projects to implement
- Ensure all projects well advertised (social media, other)

INCREASE COMMUNITY VISIBILITY & ENGAGEMENT – FUNDRAISING

• Fundraising projects to have **broad appeal** and **accessible** to many residents (e.g. Port Hope Fall Fair, Surf & Turf, Canada Day Food Booth)

- Balance fundraising with service & visibility (i.e. Some projects to have a revenue generating focus, others more about service & club visibility in the community
- Implement a major new fundraiser in February 2024 (bridge event gap between Dec & June)
- Consider a Rotary Foundation fundraiser
- Ensure all fundraisers well-advertised (social media, other)

IMPLEMENT CLEARLY DEFINED ACTION PLAN TO GROW MEMBERSHIP

• Provide members with **tools & resources** to be effective club ambassadors

- Transparency and clear expectations (e.g., membership costs, attendance, etc)
- **Invest** in ourselves (e.g. working session to practice "elevator speech", have rotary business cards with goal to distribute during year)
- Create **inclusive** membership types (e.g. ensure our club also represents working and family lifestyles): family, corporate, engage with Interactors & parents
- Create **vibrant** Friends of Rotary and Spouses partnerships. Annual event to engage and thank
- Thoughtful invitations to potential members who will engage and stay. Ask!
