Panama – facility upgrades for care of malnourished infants

Philippines – taking children off the streets and providing them with a basic education

Online Auction – The Club’s signature event. One-week live auction online. Requires collection of items with a retail value of \$100 or more. Many different committees are available to participate.

Progressive dinner – an evening with different club members at every stop. You start with an appetizer at one Rotarians home with two other couples. You then travel to a second Rotarian home for the main meal and meet 2 NEW couples. The third stop is for desert with 2 NEW couples again. The idea is that you never see the same people at any one location UNTIL the wrap up party that everyone attends! It is a great evening. You can host one of the meals.
