If you can answer "Yes" to some or all of the above, please fill out the enclosed Application. The Rotary Club of Toronto and Toronto Argonauts Community Champion Scholarship is offered to a high school graduate who live in the City of Toronto.

Instructions:

- 1. Print or type your name and school on <u>EACH</u> page.
- 2. Print or type information on pages 3-6, Personal Data and Financial Data. Do not substitute forms. Minimal additional supplemental information may be accepted.
- 3. Print or type information on pages 7 and 8, Applicant's Essay. The Essay must be original thoughts of the applicant, in the applicant's own words, written by the applicant. Use at least a 12-point font.
- 4. Recommendations, pages 9-11, must be printed or typed by the responders in at least a 12-point font.
- 5. Attach a transcript of your grades from all of your high school years.
- 6. Complete all information. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
- 7. Final Candidates must be present for a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee. Each Final Candidate is requested to bring a copy of the personal income tax form to the interview.
- 8. Successful applicants will be required to attend the recognition luncheon at the Rotary Club of Toronto at The Royal York from 12:00 noon to 1:30 pm in late May or early June. Date to be determined.
- 9. School Guidance Counsellors: Please review entire application with the student, and offer any necessary explanation and assistance, excluding the essay, which must be prepared by the Applicant only.
