Rotary International (RI) Initiatives

Toronto Eglinton and all Rotary clubs support RI's many initiatives through annual contributions to its Rotary Foundation.

RI's 6 areas of action, are: *promoting peace, fighting disease, providing clean water, saving mothers and children, supporting education, and growing local economies.*

RI's primary current initiative is *End Polio Now* which is on the verge of eradicating polio worldwide. Working with the WHO, the US Centers for Disease Control and UNICEF, Rotary International has raised over US\$850 million to inoculate more than 2 million children throughout the world against polio.
