### Accident Waiver and Release of Liability/Photo Consent

The risks include but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of athlete, equipment, vehicular traffic, actions of other people including but not limited to, participants, volunteers, spectators, coaches, event officials, and event monitors, and/or producers of the event and lack of hydration. These risks are not only inherent to athletes but are also present for volunteers. I hereby assume all of the risks of participating and/or volunteering in this event. I realize that liability may rise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained or controlled by them or because of their possible liability without fault.

## Aroostook River Fun Run

This annual event began as a partnership between the Presque Isle and Washburn Rotary Clubs to celebrate the tremendous resource that connects these two communities...the Aroostook River. The event was expanded last year to include the options of a 5K run/walk and a bike ride as well.

These three options will again be offered in 2018. While all three races happen simultaneously from different starting points, they each end at the Presque Isle Fish & Game Club in Presque Isle, where lunch will be provided to participants and awards will be presented.

**Paddle It:** Canoe or kayak down the Aroostook River from Thomas Brewer Park in Washburn to the Presque Isle Fish & Game Club. Travel by yourself, with a partner, with your kids...have a fun morning on the river! Awards provided in several categories.

**Bike It:** Bikers will depart from bus garage on Parsons Road and travel a route of 20 miles, ending at the PI Fish & Game Club. Are you taking part in Trek Across Maine or Bike Maine? If so, this is a great opportunity for training! This is a non-timed event.

**Walk/Run It:** Whether you are a runner or want to get in some exercise while walking with friends, this 5K is a great start to the season. It begins at the Community Center in Presque Isle and ends at the PI Fish and Game Club.

## Support of Local Causes

This event supports worthy causes each year. This year, all proceeds will be divided between two causes: local Veterans and the American Lung Association (in support of Mel's Trekkers who are biking in Trek Across Maine in honor of Melanie Stewart-Ring).
