FESTIVAL RULES

- 1. An entrant who does not comply with these rules may be disqualified from participating in the Festival.
- 2. In a class in which an age limit is prescribed, entry must not be over the prescribed age on the last day of December preceding the Festival.
- 3. (a) Entrants may enter older age groups than their actual age in a Section but must remain within that age group for all entries within that Section. (b) Grade choirs may enter an older level than their actual grade. (c) In duets and trios, an entrant may rise to his/her partner's age level and maintain his/her actual age for solo entries in the same section.
- 4. (a) A participant may compete in only one age group in any section as shown in the Syllabus, (b) A participant in brass, woodwind and percussion sections may compete in only one level in a section but may compete at different levels if he or she is entered in more than one section.
- 5. Conductors may be either professional or amateur. A conductor may conduct any number of groups in class or in any number of classes. Conductors may not perform with the groups which they conduct.
- 6. In CHORAL classes, the minimum number of voices required to compete is ten unless otherwise stated (e.g. Small Vocal Ensemble).
- 7. A GRADE CHOIR is a choir consisting of a group of pupils from any one grade in the school.
- 8. Except where otherwise provided, classes are competitive with marks and public adjudication.
- 9. CLASSROOM SINGING shall be the total number of pupils on the register of a classroom or a combination of classrooms within the same grade provided the total number of pupils in an entry does not exceed forty.
- 10. CLASSROOM SINGING will be non-competitive with no marks or individual public adjudication. Private adjudication sheets will be available.
- 11. Except where otherwise provided, Vocal, Piano and Instrumental Solo classes for entrants aged thirteen years and over are competitive.
- 12. Except where otherwise provided, Vocal, Piano and Instrument Solo classes for entrants aged twelve years and under are non-competitive.
- 13. An entrant in a Vocal or Choral class who has selected a song which is in a language other than English shall file an English translation, with the copy provided for the adjudicator.

- 14. Vocal solo and choral test pieces may be transposed. The adjudicator must be notified of any transpositions before the beginning of the class.
- 15. All Test pieces in must be performed from memory.
- 16. In Brass, Woodwind and String sections, repeats are to be played where indicated. In the piano and voice sections, repeats shall not be played or sung; however, Da Capo repeats should be observed.
- 17. In String classes for juniors, entrants may have their own instruments tuned by a teacher or other person.
- 18. The chord may be given on the piano at the commencement of each piece of unaccompanied music.
- 19. An entrant who is arranging for his or her own accompanist shall:
- (a) seek the willingness of the accompanist to accompany the entrant before the entrant enters the accompanist's name on the entry form;
- (b) enter the name of the accompanist on the entry form. This information is of great importance to the program committee.
- 20. Entries must be submitted on the official entry form. The entry form must be signed by the teacher of the entrant and forwarded to the address specified on the entry form accompanied by the entry fees indicated in the Syllabus. Cheques should be payable to the Rotary Music Festival Inc.
- 21. Entry forms which do not give the requested information or which are improperly completed are subject to rejection.
- 22. Entry fees cannot be refunded except where an entry is rejected due to late entry.
- 23. In cases where an entrant has a conflict in time between two classes, an immediate call might enable the Executive Secretary to resolve the problem. If not, the competitor must elect to withdraw from sufficient classes in order to resolve the conflict.
- (a) Entrants shall perform in the class order indicated in the program. The Chair reserves the right to change the order where circumstances warrant, provided a teacher who has entries in such a class is notified previously to the change. In the event of illness, accident or other emergency, a substitute may be made in duets, duos, trios, quartets, quintets or group classes provided the Chair is notified in writing, giving the reasons for the substitution prior to the time set for the performance, and provided the substitute is eligible under the rules governing the class.

- 24. The order of performance will not be changed to accommodate accompanists unless special circumstances warrant, in which case the Chair must be notified.
- 25. An adjudicator may stop a performance at any time.
- 26. The marks awarded by an adjudicator are final.
- 27. Certificates will be awarded to the three entrants gaining the highest mark in each competitive class, but a certificate will not be awarded unless the following percentages of the possible marks have been obtained:
- (a) 75% in choral, orchestra and band classes.
- (b) 80% in all other classes.
- 28. An entrant may be invited to perform at a final concert and should be prepared to appear if requested. This shall be without remuneration or payment for incidental expenses.
- 29. Complaints and protests shall be made to the Chair in writing and not to the adjudicator. A complaint or protest shall be accompanied by a fee equivalent to the entry fee of the class protested. The protest fee will be refunded if the complaint or protest is sustained by the Chair.
- 30. In classes in which any test piece is the competitor's own choice, the music should be passed in to the Secretary to the Adjudicator on the day of the performance. The following information should be provided on the cover sheet of the music: a. Class Number/Description b. Name of participant c. Title of selection and page number d. Length of time to perform e. Please number the first of each line in music score.
- 31. Memorization is mandatory for all festival classes, except for multi-instrument ensembles, Bands or instrumental groups. If music is used, adjudication may be given but the entrant will not receive a mark, be eligible for awards or compete in the Rose Bowl Competition. Note: Provincial rules state that in order for participants to be recommended to Provincials, they must have performed their concert group from memory.
- 32. Laws regarding copyright must be fully observed by the Festival. Accordingly, photocopies must not be used in the Festival. Please note that adjudicators are obligated to stop a performance where photocopies are being used.
- 33. No competitor may participate in more than 12 classes. Sight reading classes are included in this figure. Any competitor exceeding the limit runs the risk of having the excess entries refused by the secretary because of scheduling difficulties. No awards are given on the basis of the number of classes entered.
- 34. Vocalists shall not be over the age of 28. This is consistent with other disciplines and will be implemented at the provincial festival.

- ***** 35. All selections MUST be age appropriate and free of profanity and any other inappropriate language and/or actions. An adjudicator will stop a performance that does not adhere to this rule.
- 36. Students may not participate in more than once in the same class. (For example, they cannot perform in two Musical Theatre duets, or in two choirs, bands, etc in the same class.)
- 37. Groups performing in the 10-Minute Production categories may use minimal set pieces and props. The set up and striking of these sets, as well as the entire performance must fit in a 20 minute time frame.
- 38. Body mics can be used for the 10-Minute Productions and will be provided as long as they are requested by February 15, 2024.
- 39. Pre-recorded music or piano accompaniment can be used during the Musical Theatre productions. Pre-recorded music must be sent to the festival committee by February 15, 2024.
- 40. The rights to perform the 10-Minute Productions must be obtained by the performing groups.
- 41. A stage manager will be responsible for playing any music tracks for the 10-Minute Musicals. Music will be tied into the sound system by the group's own device.
- 42. Pre-recorded music for dance selections must be sent to the festival committee by February 15, 2024.
- 43. Prop or small set pieces may be used by dance groups. Group will be given a total of 10-minutes to set up, strike and perform their numbers.
- 44. All classes under the Traditional and Indigenous Categories are non-competitive and will not be given a formal adjudication. These local classes have been created to share traditional and Indigenous music and cultures.

AWARDS

- 1. An entrant who has not complied with the Festival Rules is not eligible for an award.
- 2. In the non-competitive solo classes, scholarships are awarded to entrants who, in the opinion of the adjudicators, show most promise of further development musically.
- 3. In the competitive classes in which scholarships and awards may be presented, 85% of the possible marks must be obtained in at least one performance class. (Sight reading is not considered as a performance class.)
- 4. Scholarships will be announced at the final concert and recommendations are at the absolute discretion of the adjudicators.
- 5. In Vocal, Piano and Instrumental classes, entrants must enter the sight-reading classes, as sight reading is considered in the awarding of scholarship and trophy awards including the Rose Bowl.

VOCAL, PIANO AND INSTRUMENTAL TROPHY AWARDS

- 1. In order to qualify for the Vocal, Piano and Instrumental Trophy Awards, a competitor:
- a. Must have reached his or her 13th birthday on or before December 31 preceding the Festival.
- b. Must be entered in the following classes and receive a mark not less than 85% in at least one class in these sections:
- 1. Concert Group
- 2. One other class
- 3. Must also be entered in sight reading class See Item 3 above 2.

It will be left to the discretion of the adjudicators in each of the relevant sections whether to make a recommendation at all. The adjudicators will consider the degree of difficulty of music performed as well as the standard of musicianship.

DRAMATIC SPEECH TROPHY

The Dramatic Speech Trophy may be awarded on the recommendation of the adjudicator for the best overall performance. To be eligible for this trophy, the individual/group must have entered a minimum of two selections and must have received a mark of not less than 85% in at least one. The adjudicators will consider the degree of difficulty, standard and versatility of the selections performed.

ROSE BOWL COMPETITION

In order to qualify for the Rose Bowl Competition, a competitor must have reached his or her 13th birthday on or before December 31 prior to Rotary Festival Week as well as entering one of the following Concert Groups: Vocal, Musical Theatre, Piano, Brass, Stringed Insturments, Percussion or Woodwind with a mark of not less than 85 in one class. Sight reading is also a requirement to qualify for the Rose Bowl. The adjudicators are asked to recommend not more than two solo entrants from each Concert Group section.

It is the absolute discretion of the adjudicators in each of the relevant sections:

- 1. whether to make a recommendation at all
- 2. whether to recommend one or two entrants

The adjudicators will consider the degree of difficulty of music performed as well as the standard of musicianship. In order to be recommended for participation in the Rose Bowl Competition, an entrant must receive a mark of not less than 85% in at least one class in the section he or she is to represent and must have performed in more than one class in the section. To qualify for Rose Bowl with the Musical Theatre Concert group students will need to participate in the Vocal sight singing and any other vocal class

The competitors selected for Rose Bowl Competition will perform any two of the same concert group selections as performed in the competitive sessions. The winner of the Rose Bowl Competition will be decided by a panel of the adjudicators. The winner will be announced at the final concert along with the winners of other scholarships and awards.

CHORAL TROPHY

The Choral Trophy will be given each year for the annual choral competition. It will be awarded on the recommendation of the adjudicator for the best overall performance by a choir of 12 or more singers. To be eligible for this trophy, a choir must receive a mark of 85% in a performance of two contrasting selections, one of which must be sung in two or more parts. The adjudicator can consider and recommend that the award be made to a choir entered in only one class, provided it carried out the above regulations. The adjudicators will consider the degree of difficulty of music performed and the versatility and standard of musicianship displayed by a choir in the classes in which it performed.

MUSICAL EXPRESSIONS THROUGH DANCE

The Musical Expression Through Dance Trophy will be given each year to the best overall performance by a group dance of 4 or more dancers. To be eligible for this trophy, a dance group must receive a mark of 85% in any class. The adjudicators will consider the degree of difficulty of the dance performed and the versatility and standard of the dance displayed by a group in the classes in which it performed.

A ballad is a piece with slower tempo, often of a serious or introspective nature. An up-tempo piece is a piece with a more-lively tempo. When possible, entrants should select pieces from at least two of the following Musical Theatre eras: Tin Pan Alley (1920 – 1939), Golden Age (1940 - 1959), Post-Golden Age (1960 – 1969), Pre-Contemporary (1970 – 1999), Contemporary (2000 – 2019), & Current (2020 – Present). Competitors may perform in costume enhancements (ex: hat, jacket, scarf, shawl) and one hand-held prop per selection. Competitors may leave the stage briefly for a drink of water or to make an entrance, but should not leave the stage for complete costume changes.

Students who compete in these classes are eligible to be selected for the Rose Bowl Competition. To qualify for Rose Bowl with the Musical Theatre Concert group student will need to participate in the Vocal sight singing and at least one other vocal class.

FOLK INSTRUMENTS SECTION

This category is designed to bring enjoyment to the musicians who play these instruments. Newfoundland and Labrador has a rich heritage in playing folk instruments. Irish, French and Scottish ancestry is evident in the style that tunes are played. The majority of people playing these instruments have little or no professional training. Learning is done by watching others and mimicking their style. This method often creates slight differences in the tunes with there not being a right or wrong. It is difficult to put these styles on paper, so tunes are often passed down through generations by playing with elders or listening to recordings. Very often they are played for jamming sessions, dances, kitchen parties and concerts. Jigs, reels & waltzes are some of the types of music played by these instruments. Allowance of microphones and sound check if needed for this category. Entrants in these Classes will be judged on the discrimination shown in their selection and group arrangement, having regard to contrast, keys, technique, timing, and note precision.
