Last Week's Speaker

Thank you to Shaye Moris executive director Second Harvest Northern Lakes Food Bank. Shave told us that they serve 13,200 people per month. 627 in Carlton County alone. The food bank rescues donated foods and disperses it out to local food shelves and soup kitchens. They have 12 staff members of which 7 are drivers to deliver food. They have many volunteers. With the use of volunteers they save \$108,000 a year. For every \$1.00 donated the food bank can turn that into \$10.00. 3.7 million pounds of food donated a year translates into 2.9 million meals. They have been around for 26 years. What a great service they have provided to the region.



2 weeks ago Don and Helen visited our club and Shared some of the dollhouses they have built. Don told us about a dollhouse that was built over 400 years ago in 1558 for a German Dukes daughter. After completion of the dollhouse the Duke thought it was to nice for his daughter to play with so he placed it into his art collection. Dollhouses were originally thought to be educational toys to teach home making to young girls. Don and Helen took a dollhouse making class 32 years ago with 9 others. They all enjoyed it so much that they started to meet every month since. Helen says she has lost count of the number of dollhouses she has made. She has one on display at the Cloquet Library. They also showed us many kits that can be bought to start our own new hobby.
