

Rotary foreign exchange student Eric Andersson talks about his life at home

Moorhead Rotarians got an up-close introduction to Rotary International's exchange program at Tuesday's meeting. Our current guest, Eric Andersson, took us on a whirlwind tour of his home town, Nykõping, the province of Sõdermanland and his native land, Sweden.

President Jon Benson welcomed guests and thanked members for their make-ups, including the board meeting held earlier Tuesday. He introduced Dan Eggiman, who has submitted an application to become our newest Rotarian under Corey Elmer's sponsorship.

Announcements included the need for more door prizes for Thursday's Taste of Moorhead fund raiser, along with more volunteers, plus a reminder of the upcoming District 5580 Conference coming up May 7–9 in Duluth.

Tracing the history of Rotary Exchange

Sergeant at Arms Jean Hannig quizzed members on their knowledge of Rotary's Youth Exchange program. Begun in the 1920s to offer something special for European youth, it was discontinued during World War II, then

Eric helps us brush up on knowledge of Sweden, yesterday and today

Beginning with the Swedish national anthem, "Du gamla, Du fria" ("Thou ancient, Thou free"), Eric offered a bird's eye view of his nation of nearly 10 million citizens in an area about twice the size of Minnesota.

He lives with his parents Gert and Marina in Nykõping, a city of 52,000 in the southeastern province of Sõdermanland about 90 minutes south of Stockholm. While soccer and hockey are the most popular sports in his school, he did also play American football.

Eric came to be a Rotary exchange student because of his mother, who is a Rotarian in Nykõping. He'd seen a presentation at school in the sixth grade by an Australian girl that

eventually prompted him to apply for the program. "That inspired me," he reported. "I knew I wanted to do this."

Part of the adventure was the distinct differences between the Schaefers, the Mannings and the Stormses. One of the most memorable parts for Eric, who's an only child, was living among the Mannings' young children. "Your host families teach you many things," he noted. "They give you shelter and safety and a chance to share their home and culture and traditions. "I'm grateful for every one of them."

Eric plans to attend university after he completes high school to become an attorney. Part of his future plans, too, is to become an active Rotarian.
