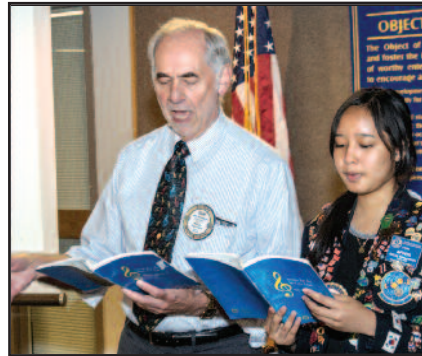

Legatt: Public art adds value to city

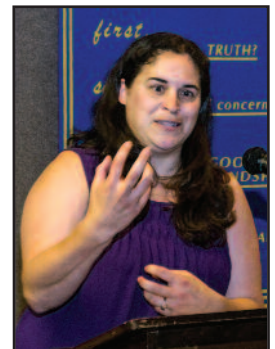

These are late-season tree-ripened Colorado peaches, grown in an ideal microclimate that concentrates flavor and sugar. A full lug (18-20 pounds) of freestone peaches is \$33; a half-lug is \$19.

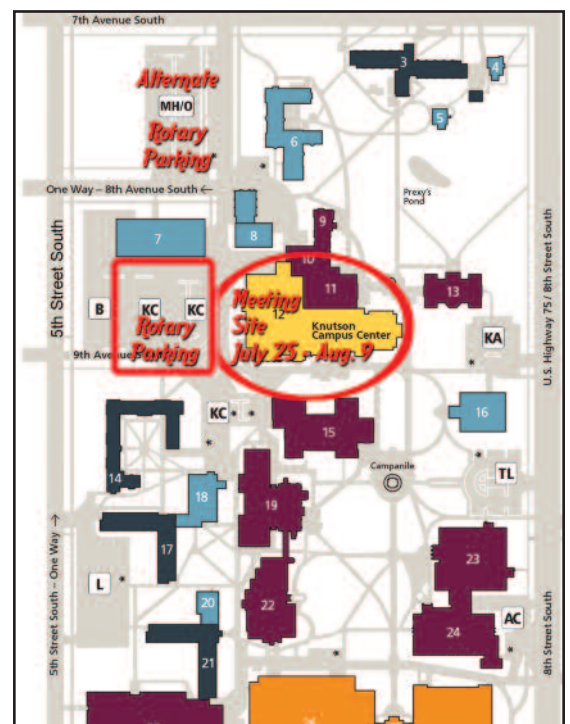
Six weeks of meetings at Concordia

Su Legatt extols Moorhead art opportunities

Su Legatt, who teaches at NDSU, gave an overview of the arts in Moorhead, old and new. She pointed out that the total number of Americans who participate and attend arts events is greater than the number who attend sports, generating (according to the Lakes Region Art Council) some \$9.8 million in the eight-county area in 2015. She said the Arts & Culture Committee is soon hosting public meetings to hear from the public about additional projects they'd like to see.
