# Jon Benson takes over program spot with reflections on visioning process

President Lynne Kovash welcomed Rotarians Tuesday. After John Andreasen led the group in "Smile, Sing a Song," the now-smiling group heard RYLA coordinator Randy Farwell's request for help delivering students to Crookston on July 9 and bringing them home on July 18. The club is sponsoring the high schoolers' participation in the annual Rotary Youth Leadership Academy, as it does every year.

#### Six weeks without a polio report!

Sergeants at Arms Gary and Cindy Nolte shared ground-breaking news from the Rotary Foundation: For the last six weeks, not one single case of polio has been reported anywhere on earth.

"Still, there is work to do, work that requires significant funding," Gary pointed out. The Rotary teams are now using injectable vaccines rather than eye drops. This means that medical professionals must administer the shots and travel to the remote areas where they're needed. The cost is very high. The Bill

and Melinda Gates Foundation continues to match clubs' donations up to \$35 million.

#### Reflecting on the visioning meeting

When our scheduled speaker failed to attend, past president Jon Benson rose to the occasion with a thoughtful discussion of our visioning session May 2. The visioning process – this was Jon's second time around – asks Rotary members what our club stands for, what our values are, and what we want our club to look like.

Looking back to our session five years ago, Jon noted that, in some cases, we accomplished what we said we wanted to do. In others, we did not. "We have to meet and find where we want to go – *AND* put this into action," he stressed.

Jon asked members to highlight their thoughts from this year. Among the responses was his own: "How do I champion those efforts at the five-club level and bring them back to our club so we can be involved?" Others added ...

**Emily Gess**: "Keep the traditional (singing, service) while growing in other service areas."

**Gary Nolte**: "We need a lot more education internally to engage members."

**Russ Hanson**: "We are still the best kept secret in Moorhead. We're shy or forget to fly our flag."

**Mike Hulett**: "We didn't decide to throw everything out and start over. Instead, we need to try and get every member involved in at least two of our activities."

**Gary Gonser**: Suggested 1- or 2-minute talks about global activities.

**Bill Wood**: "Our goal 5 years ago was expanding our dictionary program countywide ... and we did it!"

**Jon**: "Our level of involvement shows we are doing many things right, but there are still things we can do better."
