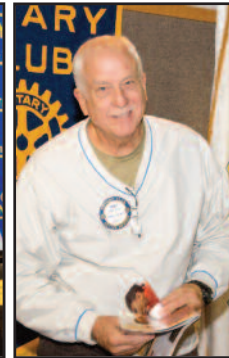
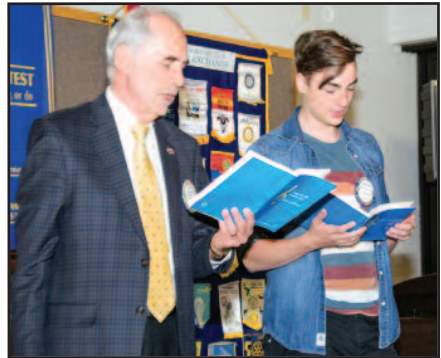

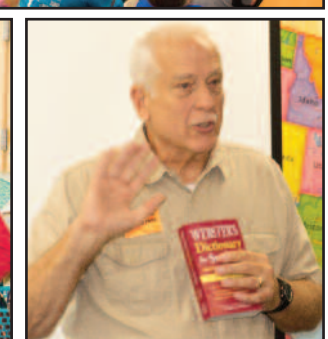
Dictionaries on their way to 3rd graders
