We're meeting online this week!

Challenging times call for a new strategy ... and, for many of us Moorhead Rotarians, an opportunity to learn something new.

Since regular meetings are out while we shelter in place to prevent contagion from COVID-19, Moorhead Rotary is adopting an online tool called Zoom. Many who are working at home may already be familiar with this online meeting platform, which not only permits users to see and hear a presentation, but to contribute to group conversation from wherever they are watching.

Our Finnish foreign exchange student, Frida Lehtonen, has volunteered to be our first presenter. Others will be speaking to us via the internet in weeks to come ... until we can resume our regular meetings.

At 11:30 on Tuesday, you can click a link in the email that's brought you this Paddlewheel. Then you'll enter a password to get into the prescheduled meeting.

But by using the link in this email, you won't have to enter any of the following information yourself. It will all be ready to go when you click. It's included here just as a back-up.

Note that Zoom will download to your device the first time you click on the link. You don't need to preload it. If you're a first-timer, allow 10 minutes or so for everything to be set up.

How will this work during the meeting?

Your mic will be muted at the time you join our meeting. We will open the microphones at a couple points during the meeting, but for most of it, they will be kept off.

You have two options for asking questions and sharing information:

- Press and hold the space bar. This temporarily un-mutes you. You can then speak up to the whole group.
- Or type your question or comment into Zoom's chat box. To activate "chat," hover your mouse over the Zoom screen; several menu options will then appear at the bottom. Click on "chat." It will open a chat window on the right-hand side of the video screen. Then type your comment or questions.

We encourage you to turn on your video! Part of the joy of meeting is seeing each other, so we want to bring that into this virtual meeting as well.

When Sergeant at Arms Jean calls for Happy Dollars, use the temporary un-mute option (pressing the space bar) or type your contribution into the chat box. We will record the amount and it add it to your next invoice ... or you can drop it in the kitty next time we're together. We'll all be on the honor system
