

Club discusses alternatives for traditional dictionary presentation to 3rd graders

President Dave Sederquist opened our meeting Aug. 16 with a video about how a Rotary club in Amherst has adopted a Syrian family. He also shared a video from District Gov. Kay Biga about her travels and district happenings. She is visiting our club on Oct. 4.

Club considers alternatives to dictionaries

Russ Hanson, co-chair of the dictionary committee, introduced a conversation about whether we should continue to provide printed dictionaries to all Clay County third-graders, as we have for 20 years. He said the Moorhead district's teachers have suggested that, instead of dictionaries, we consider globes or maps. They say that since every student now has and uses a Chromebook in school, they're looking up words

The educators say that globes will help them understand geography lessons in a way that flat and online media cannot. Russ brought samples of 16" inflatable globes that can be blown up when needed and stored flat. The cost of each globe is \$1.50. The softcover dictionaries we have presented have cost us about \$3.50 in the past.

What of students in other schools where digital devices are not as widely used? Russ will check with others around the county.

Much discussion followed. Tim Hiller, father of a third-grader, said his family would prefer the globe. Sue Koesterman reminded us of the expressed need for globes. One suggestion was to present globes to all but let kids sign up for the dictionary.

Another: offer both during a trial year.

The board will discuss the options at its next meeting. Members are being polled (in the cover email that carries this Paddlewheel) to share their own thoughts on the issue.

Sarge Dale: Polio is back!

Sergeant at Arms Dale Hetland Reported that polio has been detected in New York City. Vaccinations for children are down, as Covid caused parents to delay doctor visits. "If one person has turned up paralyzed, there are likely to be hundreds who are infected there," he said.

He went on to fine Tim Hiller for a "breach of Rotary decorum" — failing to wear his Rotary pin in the photo that was published in the Forum.
