Rotarians tour Clay County's Joint Law Enforcement Center

Clay County Sheriff Mark Empting led Moorhead Rotarians through the Joint Law Enforcement Center, which opened in 2018. Members gathered at the LEC — its address is the remarkably appropriate 911 11th Street North — on Aug. 22.

Among our guests was Randy Farwell's daughter Claire, a deputy in neighboring Cass County assigned to the jail. Jean Hannig also introduced Rotary exchange student Ansgar, a young German teen who had arrived at Hector Airport four days earlier.

President Steve Astrup invited members to take part in a five-club Rotary service project planned for Tuesday, Aug. 29. Volunteers will work together to clean up Moorhead's Davy Park. The project is planned for 4 to 6 p.m., and may be followed by a social (with details to come). If you plan to participate, meet the group in the parking lot west of the Hjemkomst Center.

26 years he has spent in law enforcement. He is also a long-time volunteer firefighter who currently serves as Dilworth's fire chief. First elected in 2018 to succeed the late Bill Bergquist, Empting won his second term in 2022.

The sheriff expressed pride in the new facility, which his department has occupied since 2018. The sheriff's department shares the LEC with the Moorhead Police Department; other law enforcement agencies, including the Highway Patrol, Drug Task Force and Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension, also have offices there.

Despite persistent recruitment issues facing the profession, he said that Clay County is nearly fully staffed, with only one courthouse position now open. His deputies patrol 1,050 square miles of the county, with just two or three on duty at any given time.

He took club members through the new, secure evidence room and the unisex locker room (with separate changing rooms). Offices are located on the upper level. While the jail was off limits, he said 99 of its 196 beds are occupied, with 52 staff. More staff would be needed to increase to 150 inmates.

He noted that satellite offices are available for Clay officers in several smaller communities.
