Moorhead Rotary elects officers for 2023-24 and honors multiple Paul Harris Fellows

President Dave Sederquist welcomed Moorhead Rotarians Feb. 21 to a special meeting all about the club and its members.

Recital with a Cause has raised \$218, 479

John Andreasen, an originator of the Rotary Recital with a Cause 12 years ago, reported on what has become a major five-club fund-raiser — both for Polio Plus, its original purpose, and also for youth musical programs in Fargo-Moorhead.

According to John, who chairs the planning committee made up of members from all the clubs, the concerts featuring the area's top young musicians has raised a total of \$218,479 since its inception in 2010. Last year, when the program resumed after several years of postponement due to Covid, its total reached \$61,112.

Polio Plus has received \$157,000 during the same period, an amount matched by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. Last year's donation was \$52,000. The funds have impacted lives around the globe, funding 225,584 vials of vaccine for more than 2 million shots.
