
Arlin & Sarah Fisher encourage organ donations in memory of late son Cameron

Moorhead Rotarians gathered for the first time in 2024 to hear grieving parents Arlin and Sarah Fisher talk of the vital gifts of life that organ donors create — a mission they have established called "Crosses for Cameron" in honor of their late son.

Their teen son was killed in a traffic accident in 2018. As a donor, his organs and tissue have been transplanted in 124 patients all over the country, with most organ transplants taking place at the University of Minnesota Hospital and Mayo in Rochester.


The couple, who have eight surviving children and two grandchildren, dispelled several myths about organ donation. They said that every major religion permits organ donations, though some do place certain restrictions. There is no maximum or minimum age for donors. While organs must be transferred in 45 hours, tissue remains viable for five years. Open-casket funerals are possible after donated organs are removed. There is no cost to the family of the donor.

To register as a donor, express your wishes when you apply for a drivers license or permit. Or go to one of several websites: DonateLifeMN.org, DonateLifeND.org, DonateLife.net, or RegisterMe.org.
