Soul Solutions seeks to help people in recovery transition for the long term

Rotarian of the Day Violet Deilke introduced Patti Senn, the licensed addiction counselor who in December 2021 opened the doors of Soul Solutions Recovery Center in Fargo.

The young nonprofit provides services for individuals and families affected by substance-use disorders. In addition to helping them transition from short-term treatment to long-term recovery, the center's staff work with their families — whom research shows are associated with higher rates of abstinence, lower rates of relapse, and improved engagement in the recovery process.

Soul Solutions's family program is the only one in the region that specifically addresses the needs of family members and other loved ones, providing support, education and guidance.

The outpatient and partial hospitalization program works with people who use a variety of drugs, from alcohol to opioids. According to Senn, 9% of North Dakota adults (18 and up) have had a substance use disorder in the past year. The state has a higher rate of binge drinking — one in three people — than the national average of 26.5%.

Excessive alcohol use alone costs North Dakota \$487,000,000 in health-care costs. Research also shows that every person's addiction affects an average of five other people. For more information on the program, go to *www.soulsolutions.org*.
