
Club awards grants to local nonprofits

President Dave Sederquist, wielding the gavel for the last time in his year-long term, reported that the board of directors has approved contributions to six local nonprofit organizations, among them \$500 to the Moorhead Business Association to support the Big Oooh Aaah, the 50th annual Moorhead fireworks display on July 4.

The other 2023 recipients include the YWCA's Emergency Shelter, serving 1,200 youth (approximately 20% from Minnesota), \$3,5090; the American Diabetes Association's Camp Maverick, \$1,000; the FM Youth Symphony, \$800; the Gooseberry Park Players, \$700; and the FM Kicks Band, \$500.
