

He saluted three members' epic anniversaries, including the Dovres, at 65 years; Dave and Sharon Tranby, celebrating 49, and Sam and Coralie Wai, 47 years.

## Recital with a Cause reached historic milestone in support of Polio Plus

John Andreasen, who chairs the five-club committee that organizes the Recital with a Cause, shared the news that this year's concert May 4 brought the total of its 12 years of contributions to Polio Plus over the top of the half-million mark ... combined with the matching gifts of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

The 2023 concert brought in \$38,246 for the Rotary International program. Gifts of \$2,500 were also presented to the FM Area Youth Symphonies and the FM Symphony Orchestra.

Moorhead Rotary members contributed \$9,175 this year, leading the quintet of FM clubs, followed by Fargo Downtown, \$3,950; FM AM, \$3,788;

#### Don't forget the groundbreaking June 15!

President Dave reminded members of the groundbreaking at 4 p.m. Thursday, June 15, for the Rotary Natural Play Hill and Bike Park. Construction is beginning for the innovative children's attraction that will be located in Moorhead's Riverfront Park area north of First Avenue North. The park, with construction costs estimated at \$1.2 million, is funded by a multi-year fund-raising campaign headed by Heather Ranck that has involved all five Fargo-Moorhead Rotary groups. The campaign is less than \$200,000 from its ambitious goal.

The ground-breaking will be followed by a social hour at River Haven, the event center just east of the park area. Members are invited to bring spouses, guests and park supporters to the celebratory event.
