



Cindy Nolte said thanks for the \$200 prize she won in this month's travel raffle while she and Gary were away meeting their new great-grandson. Teresa applauded the repair — at last! — of the handicapped entrance at the Center Mall.

Jill Berg: Links between business & talent

Rotarian of the Day Steve Astrup introduced guest speaker Jill Berg, owner & president of Spherion. The recruitment and hiring firm serves the Dakota and western Minnesota from offices in Fargo and Bismarck. She is past president of the national Spherion franchise advisory board.

Jill consults with companies all over the U.S. about finding their strengths and using them to seek out and retain workers who will use their talents to achieve results. "You cannot separate business from talent," the speaker said.

She explained the concept of "talent optimization," aligning the corporation's business and people strategy. By taking on this challenge, she said, companies have spend 31% time on people problems.

She demonstrated the technique of using the Predictive Index to predict behavioral success between employees, using the profiles of volunteers Steve Astrup and Chris Andreasen. The results predicted a behavioral/cognitive match an outcome already demonstrated by their membership here in Rotary.

She highlighted the differences between being a "boss" vs. being a "leader" ... among them driving vs coaching employees, depending on authority or on good will, inspiring fear vs generating enthusiasm, and saying "Go!" vs. "Let's go!"
