

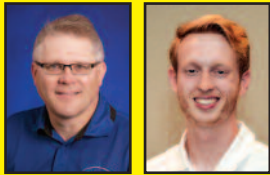

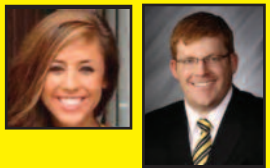

Happy news, happy dollars

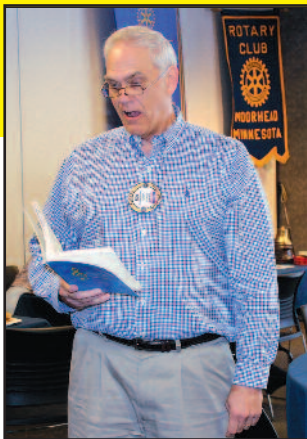

Mongeau, the second woman to serve on the board. Jenny, who lives on a farmstead near Rustad south of Moorhead, serves on more than 30 committees, as well as the F-M Diversion Flood Diversion Mitigation Task Force. She predicts the state of Minnesota will issue a permit to resume construction in the next month, based on negotiations and adjustments by the committee.

Jenny, the first woman elected to chair the commission, updated the group on progress of the new Clay County Law Enforcement Center and Correction Center, expected to be completed later this year. She said mental health programming has become a focus of the new jail facility. Thanks to a grant by Lakeland Mental Health, the jail's behavioral unit will have visits by a mental health professional scheduled daily

rather than once a week, as they are now.

The jail and law enforcement center are being funded by the half-cent countywide sales tax approved by voters in 2016. She thanked us for supporting it.

She said costs for out-of-home placements and the juvenile detention are increasing year by year. The county has just completed an agreement to partner with the city of Fargo to build a secure, modern, larger juvenile facility.

The commissioner recounted how she grew up in Clay County 4-H program — the same club her own three children now belong to. They'll soon be joined by a fourth sibling, due to join the family this spring.
