Rotarian Ron Kolb shares insights from his dentistry career in 'member talk'

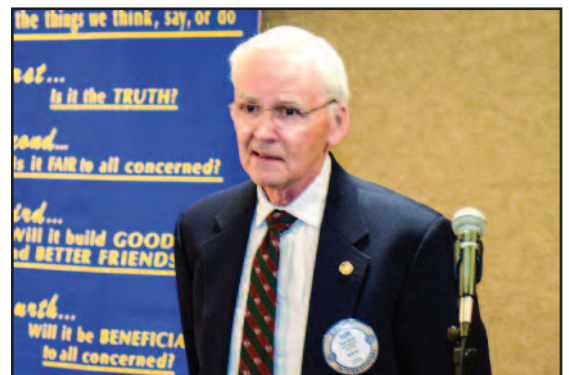

Ron Kolb tells of 50 years as dentist

Sixty years ago, a boy from Ada, Minnesota,

graduated from dental school and set out to improve the smiles of northwest Minnesota. After graduating from the University of St. Thomas, Ron Kolb headed for Marquette University, where he received his dental degree in 1959.

It launched a 50-year dental career for Rotarian Ron, who has been a member of Moorhead Rotary since 1975.

He was a dentist in the US Navy, stationed at the Great Lakes Naval Station near Chicago. There he achieved a Navy record: “I once pulled 28 teeth at once.”

He came to Moorhead in 1961, where he happens to be one of five Ada natives in the profession. Since retiring, he volunteers with Red River Valley Dental Access.

Ron and his wife, who have been married 60 years, have three adult children in the Twin Cities and seven grandchildren.
