HCSCC director describes plan to redo Hjemkomst gallery for 40th anniversary

Acting president Jerry Rogers welcomed members to Moorhead Rotary on Tuesday, Nov. 16. The meeting opened with John Andreasen's reminder of his challenge grant for Polio Plus. He and wife Carol Sue are donating \$5,000 to the cause to match donations from fellow Rotarians. The fund replaces the support for Polio Plus generated in pre-pandemic years by the Recital With a Cause, which was cancelled in 2020 and 2021. Gary Nolte said that he and Cindy will also match Foundation points for all donors.

Refresher on Rotary 4-Way Test offered by Sergeant at Arms Gary

Sergeant at Arms Gary Nolte reviewed the 4-Way Test that lies close to the heart of Rotary International. Is it true? Is it fair to all concerned? Will it build good will and better friendships? Will it be beneficial to all concerned?



Hjemkomst ship sailed 40 years ago

Rotarian of the Day Dale Hetland introduced Maureen Kelly Jonason, executive director of the Historical and Cultural Society of Clay County, who joined us to tell about plans to commemorate the 40th anniversary of the Viking replica ship Hjemkomst across the Atlantic to Norway.

It took former junior high school counselor Robert Asp seven years of his spare time to build the replica, now housed in Moorhead's Hjemkomst Center. His message "Dare to Dream" still reverberates among young and old.

The ship, she said — along with Guy Paulson's

stave church on the museum grounds — honor the builders' Norwegian heritage here in Fargo-Moorhead, where half the residents have Scandinavian forebears.

The anniversary is the impetus for the museum's renovation of the gallery where the ship is displayed. Jonason promised a big community celebration on July 23, along with the unveiling of the new interpretive exhibit. Among donors so far joining the fund-raising campaign are the Lions Club and Sanford Health.

According to Jonason several members of the cross-Atlantic crew who were in their late teens or early 20s wil be attending. One who cannot is the skipper himself, who died in 1980. He got to see his ship sail from the harbor in Duluth, but was too ill to make the historic voyage himself.
