Moorhead Legacy campaign for kids





Rotarian of the Day Jon Riewer introduced guest Patty Corwin, president of Humanities North Dakota. She noted that she taught humanities at





NDSU for 50 years, teaching 56,000 students. She also worked as a plain-clothes detective for the Fargo Police Department.

She told of the statewide group that, since 1973, has been funding scholars and experts who offer educational programs for the public across the state. Among its programs is Chautauqua and Chat, 60-minute presentations by scholars in the personas of historical figures.

"Our goal is to build community through conversation," she said. "We arrange for leading problem-solvers to present talks on the problems of the day. Then participants meet in small groups to discuss the issues."
