Dictionaries are presented to every third graders in Moorhead, Dilworth-Glyndon-Felton, Hawley and Barnesville school districts. The only Clay school not reached is in Ulen, where the Lions Club has taken over the project. Our club pays \$2.70 for each of the soft-cover dictionaries.

Centennial Literacy Project

Russ also explained that \$10,000 worth of books purchased as one of our centennial projects have been ordered and will be distributed to Moorhead's four K-4 elementary schools in coming weeks. The project is jointly funded by the club and a grant from District 5580. The books will reflect a variety of cultures, including many of the 40-plus backgrounds among the local school population.

FM Rotary Foundation Natural Playground

Jean Hannig and Dale Hetland, who represent the club on the planning committee, offered an update on progress to raise funds for the Natural Playground to be built in Moorhead's Memorial Park. Construction is expected to begin on the five-club project in April 2022. Dale said we are



encouraging 100% participation by all Fargo-Moorhead Rotary members, including outright gifts and five-year pledges. The playground will be part of Giving Hearts Day in February.
