
President Steve Astrup noted that the club is still looking for a member for the 2024 district conference planning committee.

Sergeant at Arms Tim Hiller shared highlights of the global fight to wipe out polio, drawing from the book Polio: An American Story by David Oshinsky. The campaign, he said, marked the start of American philanthropy with the famous March of Dimes, then Rotary's involvement starting in the 1980s.
