When H.N. Bishop passed away in August of 1975, the community wanted to do something to honor him. He had always been there to help promote every event and function in the Park Rapids area. At that time, it was decided to honor Mr. Bishop by recognizing individuals, who like Mr. Bishop, donate considerable amounts of their personal time to Park Rapids area clubs, organizations and events. Since that time, the Park Rapids Rotary Club has awarded a plaque each year to people who have volunteered their time and talents to community activities.
