New-Member Proposal Process

Thank you for your interest in the Rotary Club of Moses Lake. Our regular meetings are Tuesday, Noon - 1:15 p.m., at the Pillar Rock Grill at the Moses Lake Golf Club.

We encourage you to visit our club website and click on “Information on Rotary Club of Moses Lake.” This document lists expectations of club members, as well as the one-time and ongoing costs associated with membership in our club. You may also go to the Rotary International website www.rotary.org for additional information.

We strongly recommend that you visit our club at least once prior to expressing an interest to join. Our club will gladly provide lunch on your first visit. After you visit our club, if there is interest in learning more about Rotary, the Membership Committee will schedule a Club Information Meeting to provide you with an overview and further discuss expectations of local club membership and Rotary International, and answer any questions.

From there, if you are interested in becoming a member of our club, a Membership Proposal Form will need to be completed and be given to the Club President, Club Secretary, or may be mailed to Rotary Club of Moses Lake, PO Box 525, Moses Lake, WA 98837.

Because of the high ethical standards expected of Rotarians, your completed form states that you give permission to publish your name and proposed classification to our membership before you can be invited to join our club.

Here are the steps in the new-member approval process:

- The Membership Committee will review your request and make a recommendation to the Board of Directors for approval or denial.
- If the Board does not approve membership, the applicant and Proposer will be contacted and advised of the board action.
- If the Board approves your membership, the name of the proposed member will be published to the Club. After 7 days, and if no concerns about your proposed membership are received by the Board, the Membership Committee shall extend an invitation to join the club.
- If you accept the invitation, an induction date will be arranged with the Proposer and you. A one-time induction expense of \$100 will be charged on the first invoice.

The process from submission of a fully completed form to invitation to join the club should take no more than one month.
