How to help Afghan refugees

The Peace Building Committee has been in touch with Rotarian Earl Tilly, who is interested in welcoming Afghan refugee families to settle here in the Wenatchee Valley. We are in the process of determining if that is realistic, as the state and service groups are focused on settling refugees in cities with existing Afghan populations, with mosques, etc. Which means mostly in the Puget Sound area.

So for now, if we are not hosting a family in our spare bedrooms, what can we in Wenatchee do to help the refugees?

The <u>AFGHAN REFUGEE COLLECTIVE</u> is a coordinated effort of many social service organizations based in the Puget Sound region, including MAPS-MCRC (Muslim Community Resources Center), MAPS-AMEN (American Muslim Empowerment Network), Kits For Peace, Afghan Health Initiative, WA Immigrant Solidarity Network, Afghans Of Seattle, Immigrant Women's Community Center, Afghan Diaspora Hub, and other community-based organizations, working with authorized resettlement agencies (e.g., International Rescue Committee, World Relief, etc.).
