Rotarian Bryan Campbell introduced the key note speaker, Carlos Murillo, a former member of our club. Carlos then proceeded to give a resume of his difficult childhood in Guatemala, his journey to the U.S., the assistance provided by an employer mentor in Washington, D.C., and finally his move to Wenatchee. Carlos now owns and directs Cemas Construction Co. Certificates of citizenship were presented to the new citizens and the meeting broke into a noisy, happy celebration. 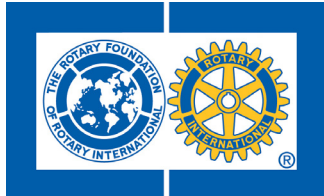
