## WENATCHEE VALLEY HUMANE SOCIETY IS GEARING UP FOR ITS 50TH ANNIVERSARY!

Founded in 1967 by Gwyneth Mitchell, the Wenatchee Valley Humane Society has been achieving its mission is to "serve the community through education, protection and pet adoptions" for 50 years. The first shelter was housed in the old "pound" building on Worthen Ave. It quickly outgrew the facility which prompted Bruce and Gwyneth Mitchell to donate orchard land on South Wenatchee Ave where a 7,000 sf shelter was built and employed 12 staff to care for the animals. With an average of 5,000 animals each year, the cinder block shelter lasted nearly 40 years, but eventually it too, was crowded and worn out. In June 2015, WVHS opened its doors to a new 16,000 sq foot shelter which includes dedicated space for Animal Care & Control, state of the art animal accommodations, an education room, treatment room, bright and welcoming lobbies, music in the animals wings, individual doggie doors and room for expansion if needed. Executive Director, Dawn Davies explains; "Our goal is to reduce the number of animals that come to the shelter by providing services that keep people and pets together. For those animals that do end up in the shelter, our new shelter helps to reduce their length of stay, in fact, our statistics are better than the national average". WVHS currently employs over 30 staff including Shelter, Animal Care & Control and Club Pet boarding services. WVHS is looking forward to the next 50 years of providing compassionate care and promoting educational programs.
