The Wenatchee Rotary Club is holding its Auction “For the Kids” on January 29, 2022. For 100+ years our club has held many auctions and raffles for our Rotary Foundation to improve the quality of life not only in our own community but communities around the world. We have built parks, provided scholarships, supported Habitat for Humanity homes, YMCA camps and programs, built a day care center in Honduras, water wells in Africa, along with clean water in Haiti.

In 2020, we raised a net total of over **\$115,683** to provide youth scholarships through the Wenatchee Rotary Foundation, Covid related grants for local nonprofits, assisting Wenatchee High School’s Interact Club project with non-profit Chelan-Douglas Land Trust, and partnering with the NCW Community Foundation to help the United Way shortages.

This year we have set a goal of raising \$150,000 with priorities to include the following:

- Help YMCA serve more youth in our valley.
- Provide support of Chelan Douglas Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA)
- Continue to support Youth Scholarships through the Wenatchee Rotary Foundation
- Help Kids enjoy Summer Camp by partnering with Camp Fire/Camp Zanika
