<u>Uniforms</u>: Men-black slacks/jeans, black shorts (no basketball shorts). Women-black slacks, jeans, capri's or shorts (no yoga pants). You will be given a red First Nation employee shirt with a serial number. You will also receive your TIPS and Mast 12 on a lanyard at the same time. The shirt will be registered to you. Men and women sizes for these shirts. Wear something light to wear under the shirt. Changing rooms or toilets are rare. Wear comfortable shoes!!

<u>Weather</u>: You may want to bring a light waterproof jacket to wear UNDER your employee shirt if you're outside. Some of the beer sales booths don't have any shelter. Perhaps a long sleeve shirt to keep you warm. If you have a Rotary hat and/or pin please wear them. People like to know that they are supporting Rotary!

<u>What to bring</u>: They (The Gorge) can inspect any bag, backpack or fanny pack. Please keep what you are bringing to a minimum. No full water bottles. There is free, bottled water for employees. Bring a small flashlight so you can see walking back to employee parking after dark. The road/path is a little rough. Some employees brought a sandwich or container of food even though there will be something provided for us while we are there. Not the best food but it is free. I would advise against bringing any type of chair. There will be times for taking breaks when needed.

The plan going to work: Meet at the Hobby Lobby parking lot at 9:30am. We will need some volunteers to drive and take up to 3 or 4 others. I will reach out to the folks who will be coming in the afternoon to drive to The Gorge and leave the Hobby Lobby parking lot at 4:00pm. It takes about 1 hr. to drive down, get through security, park, check in and walk to our sales venues. We will schedule the times to get to the venue, count all the inventory (beer and/or wine, and the money). Some volunteers will be let go early (usually about 11 pm), while the leads and others count the inventory and money so they will leave a bit later.

Getting to The Gorge: The address is 754 Silica Road Northwest, George,

WA. Take highway 28 from East Wenatchee toward Quincy. After the Rest Stop at the top of Trinity Hill, turn right on Whitetrail Road, the bypass around the city of Quincy. Follow this around to insect Hwy 281, South of Quincy, at the golf course. (WATCH OUT FOR ANY SPEED TRAP AT THE GOLF COURSE. SPEED DROPS FROM 60 to 35!) Turn right on Hwy 281 and follow the signs toward George. Turn right at the sign for The Gorge Amphitheatre. Follow the signs to The Gorge. Use GATE "C" (employee/staff gate). Go through security in your vehicle. Only the driver needs to show ID and tell them you're with ROTARY. After security, take the first left and follow the signs for EMPLOYEE PARKING/CAMPING. Turn right into this lot. Follow the dirt road through the campers/tents/cars to a tan building on the right side of this lot. Park near it. Wait for everyone to show up before heading to the General Store building to check in.

<u>Check in</u>: Get in the line at the back of the General Store, at the NPO (Non-Profit Organization) window and check in for the <u>Rotary group</u>. From there, go to the picnic tables and get an employee shirt. Men and women sizes are available. Put on your shirt before leaving this area. Get in line near the shirt table to register your shirt number (on the right sleeve) to your name and get your meal ticket for the day. Wait for the whole group to check in before going to your venue(s). The lead(s) will tell you which stand you will be working.

The plan going home: Before the concert is over, the supervisor will tell each beer stand when to shut down. All inventory (beer and/or wine, and the money) gets counted again. This is an all-hand event which makes it go very fast. The lead(s) will turn in the inventory and cash. Walk in a group back to the General Store to return your red employee shirt (in the dark! Use your flash light!). Walk back to your car near the tan building where you parked. Port-a-potties are available for that long ride home! The General Store is open late for that snack or soft drink for the road! Return home. (AGAIN WATCH OUT FOR ANY SPEED TRAP AT THE GOLF COURSE going home!)
