PRESIDENT'S AGENDA - Discussion and Action Items

Voting Members Present: 10 of 12 (Quorum = majority = 7)

- 1. Approve Secretary & Treasurer as voting board directors.
- 2. Approve monthly financials from treasurer Chris Rumbles, dated 9/30/16
- 3. Consider a goal of \$25-30K to establish reserves for potential annual losses
- 4. Summary of financial options to build reserves.
- 5. Consider designating \$3K from the \$30K Humanitarian Fund by assessing 10% administrative fee
- 6. Approve Confluence Health donation transfers to PolioPlus from Memorial Fund

DISCUSSION

1. Approve Secretary & Treasurer as voting board directors.

Secretary Frank reiterated current position of club and RI bylaws (see note at bottom). **Motion** by <u>Susan</u> (second by Jay) to make secretary & treasurer voting members. <u>Alice</u> objected to elevating treasurer, he being a paid contractor; motion amended that only the secretary shall be a voting member at this time. Pete suggested all club be informed. **Approved**.

- [Required for future quorum = 7 of 13 (no change.]
- 2. Approve monthly treasurer financials. Discussion. Motion by Don to approve (second by Jay). Appr
- 3. Consider a goal of \$25-30K reserves. Discussion. Motion by Jay (second by Alice). Approved.
- 4. Summary of financial options to build reserves. Several related issues were discussed [see attached agenda]
 - a. Transfer existing \$10.779 in Maintenance/undesignated funds to a capital reserve account.

 Motion by Susan (second by Don;...abstention by Jay)

 Approved
 - b. Sitting fee? No support for such nickel/dime items, unless voluntary, but should seek items with major impact.
 - c. **Motion** by Susan (second by Jay) to use following items to restore club cash reserves, based on treasurer's attached list of options (created following BOD discussion of 9/8/16). **Approved**
 - Allocate 10% of net proceeds from January auction
 - Increase membership
 - Cut 3 items from 2016-17 expense budget (Allocate Treasurer time on Foundation to the Foundation; eliminate expenses of 7080 Website [\$1,116, not charged yet this quarter for old web site] and finally \$7275 RI Convention, \$3,000.)
- 5. Approve Confluence Health donation transfers to PolioPlus from Memorial Fund.

Jim reviewed history of the CH \$15K donation toward the \$80K Cadman memorial. Various options discussed, including donating it to PolioPlus for the 2:1 Gates match, and replacing it later. Discussion trended toward returning the funds to CH, but no action needed or taken today.

[secretary note on quorum/board repeated from 10/13 minutes– From new RI Bylaws - Article 2 Board - The governing body of this club is its board of directors, consisting of, at a minimum, the president, immediate past president, president-elect, secretary, and treasurer. (club bylaws make secretary/treasurer BOD-optional Article 1, par. 4. Quorum: one-third of the club's members for club decisions and a majority of the directors for club board decisions (this agrees with current club bylaws. Club has 14 BOD members if secretary/treasurer are included; thus a quorum is 8).

Special Board Meeting, October 19, 2016

Board members, see below the conversation that started when I asked Chris about a savings account at CVB on the Wenatchee Rotary balance sheet on 9/30/16 with a total of \$13,779.20. He'd been thinking about it too and researched Board minutes to find the Board split the money as follows in 2007:

\$5,000	is Club Maintenance Designated
\$8,700.92	is undesignated.
78.18	is other

It appears the current Board can declare all of these funds as Club Maintenance, or capital reserves. Chris has transferred \$3,000 from the undesignated funds to our checking account to pay immediate needs. That leaves \$5,000 in Club Maintenance Designated and \$3,778.18 in undesignated, for a total of \$10,778.18 in cash reserves.

Our cash flow problem is not as severe as we thought. Our operating income and losses the past ten years have varied from a high income of \$9,600 to a loss of \$14,400. So a reserve of \$25-30,000 would give us a 2:1 coverage of our worst year's loss. We should consider \$25-30,000 as a goal for our reserves and make a motion on that today.

Those planning on attending today are: Frank, Jay, Maynard and child, Don, Joe, Susan, Pete, Mario and me, which is a quorum. Here is our revised agenda:

- 1. Approve the Secretary and Treasurer as Voting Members—RI Constitution and By-laws for Clubs indicate this is permissible. -- Clifton
- 2. Monthly financials September 30, 2016 -
- 3. Considering a goal of \$25-30,000 to establish reserves that cover potential annual losses.
- 4. Summary of Financial options to build reserves -- attached
- 5. Consider designating \$3,000 from the Humanitarian Fund by assessing a 10% percent administrative fee for the \$30,000 in the budget.
- 6. Approve Confluence Health donation transfers to Polio Plus from the Memorial Fund attached resolutions and language for CH.
- 7. Other?
