


This is NOT the Wenatchee Rotary Foundation (WRF), founded in 1980.

HOW DID THE ROTARY FOUNDATION GET STARTED?

The Rotary Foundation (TRF) started by Rotary International in 1917 when Rotary International's sixth president, Arch C. Klumph, suggested an endowment fund for Rotary "to do good in the world." It was officially named in 1928.



GROWTH

It has grown from an initial contribution in 1917 of \$26.50 from the Rotary Club of Kansas City, Missouri, to more than \$4.4 billion dollars in total contributions.



FIRST GRANT

TRF made its first grant of \$500.00 to the International Society for Crippled Children in 1930, and to this day, it continues to "do good in the world" in the name of Rotary.



TRF MISSION

TRF helps Rotary members to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace by improving health, providing quality education, improving the environment, and alleviating poverty.

501(c)3 It is organized as a public charity operated exclusively for charitable purposes and governed by a Board of Trustees.





TRF enjoys a 4-star rating, their highest.... ...92% (or more) of funds raised go to program awards and operations.

Plus all related labor is from volunteers.



Areas of Focus

- Disease prevention and treatment
- Water, sanitation, and hygiene
- Maternal and child health

Paul Harris Fellow (PHF) Award

PHF Award is given to persons who donate \$1,000 to TRF* OR, accumulate 1000 Foundation transfer points, or a combination.

Each \$ donated earns 1 transfer point.
