

## Institution Snapshot 2020-21



- ▶ **4** Bachelor's Degrees
- > 7 Associate Degrees
- ▶ 60 Programs & Certificates
- > 242 Faculty (full-time & part-time)
- ► 137 Staff (classified & exempt)
- > \$30.7M Operating
- **\$16.2M** Capital

#### Federal Stimulus Funds

- Funding in 2020-21: \$2.27 million
- Funds designated for COVID related lost revenue and expenses:
  - ▶ Tuition, dorms, food service, parking etc.
- Some exceptions:
  - Athletics, marketing, etc...
- Student Support
  - Financial aid, housing, food, etc.
  - ► Federal funds supplemented by WVC Foundation for ineligible students




