

## **ROTARY INTERNATIONAL**

### **PURPOSE OF ATTENDANCE**

- 1. To foster fellowship among club members.**
- 2. Give you an opportunity to make new friends and keep in touch with established friends.**
- 3. It helps to keep you in touch with current events of your club, district and Rotary International.**

### **ATTENDANCE CREDIT**

- 1. Attend or make up at least 60% of regular Rotary Club meetings in each half of the year.**
- 2. Attend at least 30% of the Southwest club's regular meetings in each half of the year.**
- 3. Must not miss or fail to make up 4 consecutive meetings.**

### **ATTENDANCE FOR A MEETING**

**You must be present for at least 60% of your meeting for it to count toward the attendance requirement. If a meeting is 60 minutes you must be there for 36 minutes.**

### **MAKE – UPS**

- 1. Attend another club meeting.**
- 2. Attend a Rotaract or Interact Meeting.**
- 3. Attend a District or R.I. function.**
- 4. Be a part of a club sponsored event.**
- 5. Attend a board or committee meeting**
- 6. The board can consider an excused absence. Written reasons must be submitted to the board A.S.A.P..**
- 7. If you visit a Rotary Club on their regularly scheduled place and time and they have changed for some reason you are excused.**

### **ATTENDANCE EXEMPTION**

**The board can designate you to be SENIOR ACTIVE if your age and years of membership equal 85 years. Example: you are 60 years old and have been a member of Rotary for 25 years.**
