## **The Honorable Terri LeBlanc**

Judge Terri recalled last week's snowstorm and asked members to speak about acts of goodwill or kindness they either witnessed or participated in after the unprecedented snowfall. Several Club members described their experiences in helping neighbors and coworkers, or in receiving help from others. Contributions were made in recognition of these acts of kindness.

## **Program**

Ken Gamboa, Director of Marketing for the Tri-Cities Cancer Center, was introduced. Ken began his presentation by reminding the Club the Tri-Cities Cancer Center is celebrating 25 years of caring for our community. The Cancer Center provides world-class cancer treatment, survivorship, prevention and early detection programs.

Ken explained the Cancer Center is a partnership of Kadlec, Lourdes Health and Trios Health. It opened in 1994 as a freestanding non-profit cancer treatment facility, serving patients within a 100 mile radius. Since then, the Tri-Cities Cancer Center has become a community resource for cancer treatment, support, education, and information.

The Cancer Center's mission is to provide and coordinate the highest quality, compassionate cancer care for our community. In addition to providing treatment, the Cancer Center focuses



also on cancer prevention by providing numerous free cancer screenings throughout the year. Ken highlighted the Center's partnership with our hospital owners and area physicians to provide this valuable service, emphasizing early detection saves lives.

The Tri-Cities Cancer Center offers a Lung Cancer Screening program that is available throughout the year and this cancer screening is the only one with a fee. For colorectal cancer pre-screening, the Center offers a kit for the detection of hidden blood in the stool which may be done in the privacy of your home. This test is for screening purposes only and does not take the place of other recommended screening tests, including the colonoscopy.

Looking toward the future, Ken stated the Tri Cities Cancer Center is striving to fill gaps in their service, to include transportation and lodging. After his presentation, Ken fielded several questions from Club members regarding the Tri-Cities Cancer Center and related topics.

Bob closed this week's Rotary meeting by asking Jim Bauer to lead the Club in reciting the Four Way Test, the ethical guide for Rotarians in their personal and professional relationships: Is it the truth? Is it fair to all concerned? Will it build good will and better friendships? Will it be beneficial to all concerned?
