Program

Our program today was Officer Rick Kane of the Richland Police Department and their Community Services officer and VIPS coordinator. Rick presented an extensive Power Point presentation that covered all aspects of his job and the various ways there are to protect ourselves from crime, including: personal safety, auto theft and vehicle prowl protection, burglary prevention, alarm systems, and identity theft protection. Officer Kane said that if you find yourself in an uncomfortable situation, trust your instincts and get away from there. Most of his advice was just simple common sense that, unfortunately too often, we all ignore. He suggested that we all carry a cell phone and don't be afraid to set off your car's horn if you have a problem—even in the dead of night by keeping your car keys next to your bed. Don't let people into your home unless you know them. Keep the bushes around your



front door trimmed. Install 3' screws and a heavier striker plate. Don't let newspapers accumulate in front of your house—it says you are either away or dead inside. Make sure your burglar alarms are

connected to a service. Shred your documents. Don't give out your personal information. Keep a list of your credit cards. Install anti-malware and spyware on your computer. Report crime and all suspicious circumstances.
