## **Program**

Our speaker today was Dr. Rick Schulte, the new superintendant of the Richland School District. Dr. Schulte has had an interesting career in teaching in a number of very interesting places, including a small island in the Pacific during his tenure in the Peace Corps.

He came to Richland from Oak Harbor on Whidbey Island. He provided an overview of what he has learned about the RSD since he arrived. The school district is growing. There are 300 additional students this year. More than 1,000 students requested transfers into the district and most were able to be accommodated. We also have more children living under the poverty line. All of these factors cost money. Federal sequestration has made things more difficult and cost the district \$400,000 last year. It faces an \$800,000 short-fall in special education. \$5.6 million in new funds was received from the State of Washington but it was all committed by special strings attached to the funding.



The district is going through a major construction program as a result of the school bond issue that was passed last year. Existing schools are receiving upgrades and three new schools will be built. A new middle school is about two years off. The district will be asking voters to approve its school levy in February.

All in all, Dr. Schulte provided a picture of a school district facing and meeting challenges with confidence and a vision for the future.
