Eventually a Paul Harris Society was formed in his honor, and donations of \$1000 to this group bestow the status of Paul Harris fellow on a member, and such donations earn Rotary points which can be used by the donor to extend Paul Harris fellows to other members, friends and family. Donations to Paul Harris Society are used for Rotary programs, including Polio Plus, which after 30 years has eliminated polio from all the world except two countries, so we are close to our goal. Linda announced that she and Jim were using their points to honor her parents and their five children. Larry then called up Jim Bauer and presented him with his Paul Harris pin with 4 sapphires. Congratulations to Jim and all of the Bauer family!
