If you ever wanted to know about wormholes, black holes, gravity, time and space warps, you should have been there!








The above photos depict an excited crowd, top, a close up view of Jupiter, bottom right, and what the night sky looks like right outside the CBC Planetarium.





The Orion constellation is highlighted in the night sky and Jupiter is shown close-up from an orbiting vessel. Another fascinating bit of trivia is that Betelgeuse means armpit in Greek and it is the ninth-brightest star in the night sky and second-brightest in the constellation of Orion. And you thought it was a movie?




