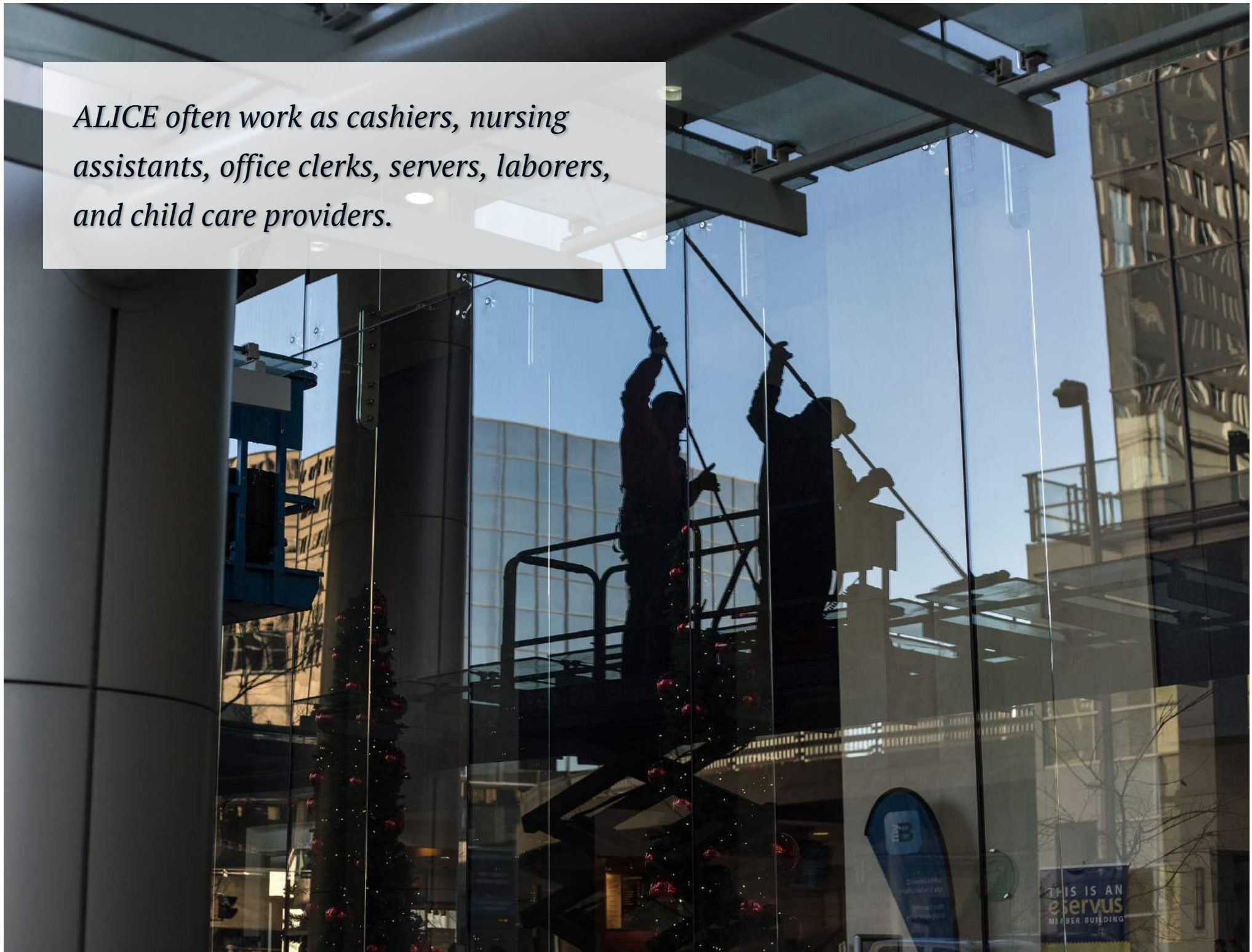

# Who is ALICE?

- **Asset Limited:** has no safety net in times of crisis.
- **Income Constrained:** not enough to afford basic household necessities.
- **Employed:** working, yet financially at risk.

*ALICE often work as cashiers, nursing assistants, office clerks, servers, laborers, and child care providers.*





**The ALICE Report provides a framework, language, statistics, and tools to measure and understand the struggles of a growing number of households in our communities that do not earn enough to afford basic necessities.**

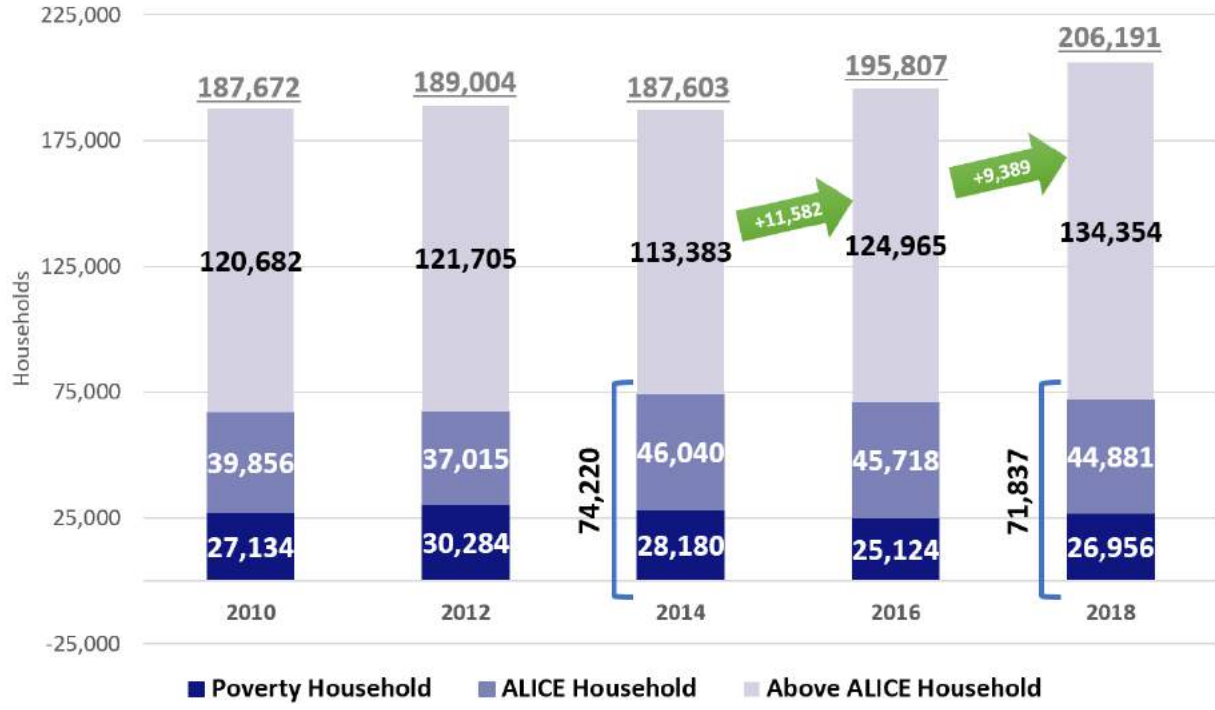

# How Has the Number of ALICE Households Changed Over Time in Spokane County?





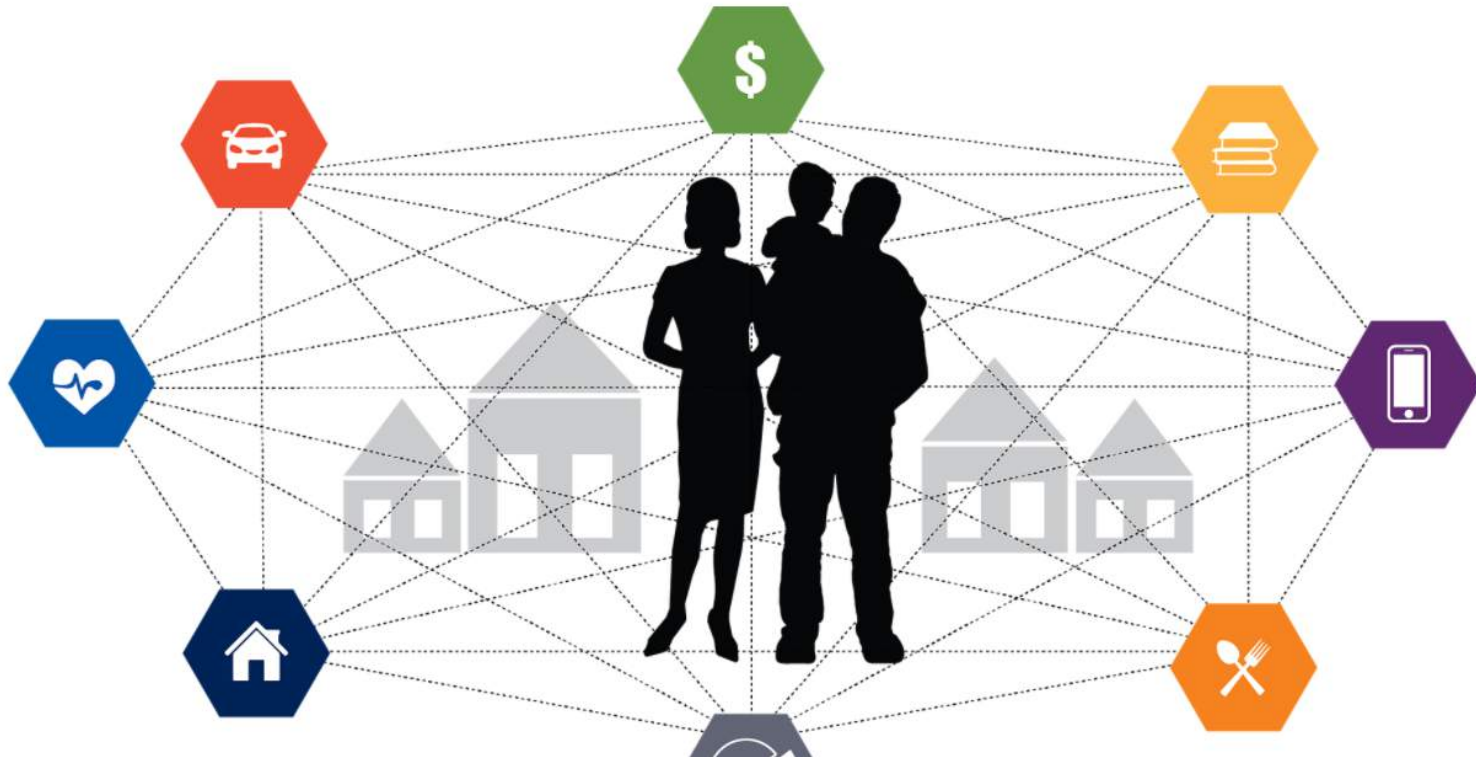

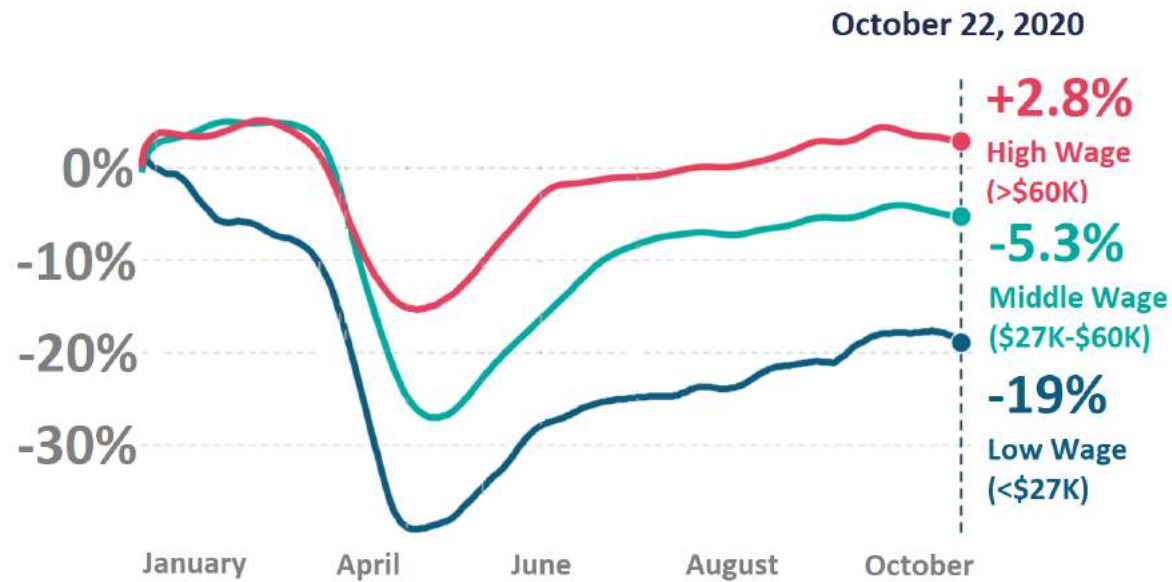
