Community Service Committees

The Rotary Community Service Committees work throughout the year to seek and fund projects and support charities and individuals in need. A total of 133 separate grants and scholarships were given this year. We are so thankful for the hundreds of volunteer hours our members committed to seeing these funds make a difference in the lives of so many.

Civic Affairs Committee

Total Annual Grants Awarded \$71,727 to 28 projects. Highlighted projects include Family Promise - Pest-Treatment Chamber: Shalom Ministries – Four Pan Hot Table: Meals on Wheels – Food Packs: Women's and Children's Free Restaurant – meals; Caritas Outreach – refrigerators.

International Service Committee

Total Annual Grants Awarded \$20,921 to 9 projects. Projects include – Spring of Hope International in western Kenya. The Rotary Malaria Partners in Zambia, and Rotary Club of Bahia de Caraguez, participated in service projects like cleaning trash from the mangroves along the Rio Chone. We purchased, with the Bahía club, commercial dryer for a 40 bed COVID-19 isolation facility. We contributed to a nutrition project in the Amazon that used old dugout canoes as raised beds for growing vegetables, World Relief Spokane; Australian Bush Fire Relief.

Foster Kid Fest Committee

Total Annual Grants Awarded \$3,181 to 5 projects. Among them were the Mobius Foster kid party; DSW Shoe Gift cards; Embrace WA – Sally's House.

Vaccinations Committee

Total Annual Grants Awarded \$2,354 to 6 projects, including Camp Creative and support for various onsite Vaccinations

Special Projects

Rotary Fountain Fish - \$245

Youth Services Committee

Total Annual Grants Awarded \$50,668 to 24 projects. Highlighted projects include, Supporting and adopting Stevens Elementary School; Bite to Go Program; Spokane Jazz Orchestra Tickets for Students.

Disabilities Committee

Total Annual Grants Awarded \$19,976 to 19 projects. Grants range from hearing aid repair, generator for critical life support, to therapeutic exerciser.

Vocational Services (Scholarship) Committee

Total Annual Grants Awarded \$16,398 to 23 Scholarships. The Katy Reeves Performing Arts Scholarship \$5,000 to 5 Scholarships.

Veteran's Affairs Committee

Total Annual Grants Awarded \$8,272 to 10 projects. Highlighted projects include Goodwill Industries support at-risk veteran's program, PPE for the Spokane Veteran's Home; Veteran's Picnic.

Partners for Work Committee

Supported three Associates for a total of \$1,582.

Rotary Special Response Strike Force

Rotary Special Response Strike Force was created in response to the Covid-19 Pandemic. The Strike Force met the increased needs in our community. The capstone project to support 2nd Harvest Food Bank raising \$15,550 from the Special Strike Force Campaign and \$15,000 from the RCS Reserves -Totalling -\$30,550.




